








START & EVENT LOCATOR OVERVIEW MAP










SPECIAL RULES & INFORMATION

GENERAL

Held under USAC Permit #09-2100. All USAC Regulations apply. Specific regulations follow.

ELIGIBILITY Juniors

Junior championships are open only to riders with racing ages in the specified ranges and who are USA citizens or permanent residents as shown on their licenses. Only USA Citizens may compete in National Championships that are exclusively for the ages of 17 and 18.

Junior Men aged 15-16 and 17-18 are restricted to road category 1-3 for the Individual Road Races and Criteriums.

Under 23

Under 23 Championships are open only to riders with the racing age of 19 to 22 who are USA citizens as shown on their licenses. Note that U23 riders on a UCI Protour team are not eligible for the U23 event.

U23 men and women are restricted to road category 1-2 for the road races and criteriums.

Elite

Elite National Championships are open only to riders with a racing age of 17 or higher who are USA citizens as shown on their licenses, subject to the following category restrictions:

For the Road Races, the Elite Men are restricted to road category 1, and the Elite Women are restricted to road category 1-2.

Riders who are on a UCI men's road team are not eligible for the elite events.

REGISTRATION

On-line registration is preferred, and will save you extra fees. Registration is available through

http://new.sportsbaseonline.com

Standard On-line registration opens May 30th and closes July 6th. Late online registration opens on July 7th and closes on July 22nd. Late online registration is subject to a \$25 surcharge. Late in-person registration is available at the packet pick-up area up to the evening before each event, assuming the field maximum sizes have not been met. Late in-person registration is subject to a surcharge equal to the original entry fee (double the original entry fee). There is no day-of registration for ANY of the events.

Field maximums are as follows: Road Races: M/W16 and under are 125, M/W 17 and older are 200. Criterium: M/W16 and under are 125, M/W 17 and over is 150, Time Trial: Unlimited.

PACKET PICK-UP

Athletes who have pre-registered may pick up their packets between **7PM** – **9PM** any of the evenings before their event at no extra charge.

Day-of race packet pickup and replacement numbers are available for an additional \$20 charge for one hour only the morning of each event (see schedule).

You may designate a coach, friend or teammate to pick up your number packet









for you during evening hours provided your designated person has the following in his or her possession:

- A signed letter requesting your numbers be picked up
- A signed and completed 2009 USAC Release Waiver (Juniors must also have parent's signature)
- Your signed 2009 USAC racing license
- For riders 17 and older, a copy of your US passport or birth certificate if you have a domestic (not-international) license that says "limited"
- Designated person must have ID

EQUIPMENT AND GEAR RESTRICTIONS

Equipment. All bicycles used in National Championships (for age 17 and older riders) must comply with the current UCI regulations. For a guide to UCI bike measurements, see

https://www.usacycling.org/forms/officials/BikeMeasureForCommissaires101.pdf

Junior Gears. Blocked gears are not allowed for National Championships. All tests for compliance shall be done using the "roll-out method." The limit for all junior ages is a development of 7.93 meters (26 feet), which roughly translates to a 52X14. Junior riders participating in Elite events must use junior gearing.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Parking is extremely limited at some race venues. Please respect the **No Parking** signs and follow the instructions of the parking marshals.

Feeding is only permitted during the road race. Athletes should ensure they carry sufficient beverages for the criterium and time trial. The current UCI schedule of fines and penalties [UCI article 12.1.040 "other events"] will be used.

NEUTRAL SUPPORT



Neutral support will be provided by Shimano. However, riders

may provide their own wheels to the pit locations specified or to the neutral service vehicles. Locations are specified on the maps for each discipline.

TEAM SUPPORT VEHICLES

U23 Elite Men/Women: Teams with three or more riders entered in a single Road Race category may have a team vehicle in the caravan. The number of vehicles may be altered based on circumstances. The vehicle must be less than 1.6 meters high (standard sedan). The driver of the vehicle must comply with **all** of the following, no exceptions:

- Have proof of insurance
- Present a valid driver's license
- Present a current USAC license
- Attend the Caravan Driver's meeting 7PM, Shilo Inn the evening before

Team vehicles may only support **one** team each. The order of the team vehicles will be determined by random draw at the caravan drivers meetings.

RESULTS

Athletes <u>registering on-line</u> and submitting a valid email address will receive daily email results for their category. This option is not available for late registrants. Results will also be posted near the finish line on the SBO trailer, at the race headquarters, at the host hotel lobby, and on the official web site on a daily basis. The protest period concerning results is 15 minutes after posting, after which time they become FINAL. Protests concerning









the order of finish are to be lodged with the Chief Judge. Final results will be posted to the USA Cycling web site.

DOPING CONTROL

USA Cycling has a zero-tolerance policy for doping in our sport. The testing protocol will be that of the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA). For the official and most updated list of the "prohibited classes of substances and prohibited methods," please refer to www.usantidoping.org . Athletes are responsible for checking the doping control list after each event. Any rider listed must appear at the USADA testing area immediately after finishing their event.

AWARDS

Awards shall consist of a first place jersey and medals to five places. The U23 women will race with the Elite women in the road race and the time trial. For these two events, the best U23 rider in the Elite event will receive a National Championship jersey and a gold medal. No other medals will be awarded.

Awards ceremonies will take place at the Old Mill Plaza every evening from 6-7PM Tues – Friday for all categories that have raced that day. Awards ceremonies will take place according to the scheduled times on Saturday at the Old Mill Plaza and on Sunday at the criterium venue.

The top five places in each competition must present themselves to the awards podium five minutes before the scheduled presentation. Suitable cycling attire must be worn to the awards ceremony. Athletes are encouraged to wear their full cycling kit (jersey and shorts). At a minimum the team jersey must be worn.

MEDIA

Medal winners and new National Champions may be asked to participate in interviews and press conferences immediately following the podium awards presentations. We ask athletes to be open to granting interviews with the media at a convenient time. The media relations contact for the championships is Kerri Kahn 719-231-2041.

MEDICAL FACILITIES

First aid stations are located near the Finish line of each event. Ambulances will be on call. For medical emergencies outside of competition timelines, dial 911.

Paracycling National Championships

GENERAL

US Paralympics, a division of the USOC, governs Paralympic sport in the United States. Paralympic National Championships and other Paralympicspecific events, whether conducted by the U.S. Paralympics or USA Cycling, will be conducted in accordance with International Paralympic Committee (IPC) adaptations to published UCI rules. These regulations can be found at www.paralympic.org and www.uci.ch

ELIGIBILITY

In paracycling road competitions, the minimum age for the youth category shall be the year of the rider's 14th birthday.

All athletes must hold a valid USA Cycling annual license. This license must be presented at packet pick-up.

EQUIPMENT

Paracycling equipment will be checked for conformity with the UCI Paracycling regulations.

REGISTRATION

On-line registration is preferred, and will save you extra fees. Registration is available through Sportsbase Online, http://new.sportsbaseonline.com/. On-line registration opens on May 30th and closes on July 22nd. Late registration is available in person on-site at packet pick-up up to the evening before each event, and is subject to a surcharge equal to the original entry fee (double the original entry). There is no day-of registration available for any event.

PACKET PICK-UP

Riders who have pre-registered may pick up their packets at REI from noon to 8PM Monday July 26 or between 7PM – 9PM Tuesday through Thursday, July 27-30. Replacement numbers and day-of packet pickup will be available before the start of each day's event for an additional \$20 late pick-up fee.

AWARDS

The event will be run as a combined competition. National Champion Jerseys (4 total) and medals will be awarded to the top three men and top three women athletes in the results from the combined bicycle and tandem rankings and the combined hand cycle and tricycle rankings, using the US Paralympic national factoring standards. Awards will take place at 7PM at the Old Mill Plaza (see map/directions). Cycling attire (jersey, shorts) is mandatory.

The top 8 riders from last year's championship event, if present, will be called to the start line first. Athletes who were in the top 8 from the last year's championship but have moved up an age

category (e.g., 17-18 into U23) will be called second. No other athletes will receive a call-up.

FEED ZONE:

Please see feed zone locations on the maps provided. Feeding is permitted only on the right side of the road. Team support vehicles are to depart prior to the start of the race.








16 AND UNDER JUNIOR ROAD RACES COURSE MAP














ELITE/U23/JR 17-18 ROAD RACE COURSE MAPS

START TIME & BIKE CHECK:

The final starting times for the Time Trial will be posted as soon as possible after the close of registration. A preliminary list of estimated start times for each group (not each athlete by group) will be posted to the web site and at packet pick-up the evening before the time trial. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR START TIME WITH THE FINAL POSTING AS LATE ENTRIES MAY CHANGE THE LIST!!

- **Juniors 10-16** athletes are to present themselves to the roll-out area at least 10 minutes before their assigned start.
- Juniors 17-18, U23, Elite, and Paracycling athletes are to present themselves to the roll-out and bike check area at least 15 minutes before their assigned start.
- Bicycles may be courtesy checked earlier, but if the bicycle leaves the official bike check area, it will have to

be checked again just before the start. Give yourself time to get your bike checked and possibly to make repairs.

NUMBERS:

Bicycles: one number positioned low in the center of the back but above the shorts line. Hand cycles: one number on each leg, one number visible from the back and slightly above.

ROAD CLOSURE:

The roads will be closed to non-race traffic one hour before the start of the first rider (7:00 AM).

START INTERVALS:

Starts will be given on 30-second intervals for most of the categories. An estimated 5 to 10 minute gap will be given between categories, with a longer break around noon. Start times will be posted.






JUNIOR/PARACYCLING TIME TRIAL COURSE MAP



SKYLINERS TIME TRIAL












ELITE/U23 TIME TRIAL COURSE MAP

Two body numbers and one frame number.

EQUIPMENT CHECKS:

Junior gears may be courtesy checked 15 minutes before each Junior event. Immediately following each Junior event, all participants are required to report immediately to the holding corral for bike check.

No extensions that point forward or upward (e.g., time trial bars) are permitted on bicycles.

CALL-UPS:

The top 5 riders from last year's USAC championship event for the age category (if present) will be called to the start line first. If an athlete from the previous year's top 5 is moved into the next higher age category, they will not be called to the line.

AWARDS:

Awards presentations will take place at the Old Mill District on Saturday as scheduled and at the criterium venue on Sunday shortly after the start of the next event. See the schedule below. Race attire is required.
