The **Tour de Grove** is part of the **USA Crits Series**. Riders in the men's and women's professional events will be competing for the **USA Crits** series points as well as the **USAC NCC** points series.

- The King of the Grove Competition: For the Men's Professional/USAC Cat 1 Event the rider who leads the most laps throughout the race will win the KOG Prize- \$500 and Merchandise. The KOG/QOG sprint point will be the Start/Finish Line.
- **US Handcycling** categories will be Men's HC1, HC2, HC3, HC4 and Open Women. Medals will be awarded to the top three athletes in each category. There will be an overall prize list of \$1000 paid 15 deep- regardless of category.
- The Queen of the Grove Competition:; For the Women's Professional/USAC Cat 1/2 Event- the rider who leads the most laps throughout the race will win the QOG Prize- \$500 and Merchandise.
- Course Description: A flat, technical 1.7 mile circuit. Course features an aggressive final turn, two bridge crossings and a flat wide open finish. There will be neutral support and rolling enclosure for all categories.

- Race day registration will close 30 minutes prior to each event.
