



2013 TD Bank Mayor's Cup Saturday, September 21, 2013

Overview

The fourth annual TD Bank Mayor's Cup is an exciting part of Boston's annual Hub On Wheels citywide bike ride, the most spectacular cycling weekend festival on the East Coast. More than 200 top professional racers descend upon Boston for high speed, fast action racing, navigating 40-50 laps of a tight .7 mile circuit around Government Center.

The Men's and Women's Professional Criterium are the season's final race of the USA Cycling National Criterium Calendar. TD Bank Mayor's Cup is followed on Sunday by the Hub On Wheels citywide ride, when nearly 5,000 riders, young and old, beginner and experienced, take to the streets. An expo and festival take place throughout the weekend on City Hall Plaza, ensuring thousands of spectators for this action-packed race in the heart of historic downtown Boston.

Course Details

Nearly flat, 4 corner Criterium in downtown Boston. Laps are .7 mile. Start/ Finish on Cambridge Street. Primes at start/finish line only.

Course Direction:

Anti-clockwise; Start on Cambridge St, right on New Sudbury St, right Congress St, right on State/Court St.
