3 Venues! Devou Park UCI Cat 2 / Kingswood Park UCI Cat 1 / Harbin Park UCI Cat 2

One of the oldest cyclocross race weekends in the Midwest, the 2013 Cincinnati International Cyclo-Cross Festival encompasses three days of UCI ranked events in the greater Cincinnati area the long weekend of November 1/2/3.

Cincinnati Cyclocross, Inc is a 501c3 not-for-profit organization set up to promote area cyclocross and develop youth cyclocross through proceeds from cyclocross event production and corporate sponsorship. All proceeds from the Cincy3 weekend benefit local youth racing.

Registration:

Race pre-registration for all categories is available beginning August 1st at 7am. Elite Men and Elite Women pre-registration only. Day of registration will be available (with the exception of UCI Elite men and women) for riders on-site at all three events for an additional \$10 (with the exception of junior categories). Riders must register for category on their racing license. No upgrades will be available on-site.

Refunds: No refunds, no exceptions.

ZIPP Raffle for the Triple: Huge mega-raffle *only* for those hardcore crossers that pre-reg for all 3 days of racing. Grand prize a pair of ZIPP 303 Disc wheels! See below for details.

Racing License:

USCF license required for all categories with the exception of free kids races. Temporary one-day license available for purchase on-site at events for all Cat 4 categories only. For Cat 1/2/3 - annual license is required (also available to purchase on-site). Registration staff will be checking licenses at number pickup - license must be present to race. UCI International License required to race Elite Men, Women, and 17-18 Junior races.

Starting & Staging Procedure:

UCI Mens, Womens and Juniors Elite Events (UCI rule 5.1.043): starting order to be determined by latest published UCI cyclo-cross ranking, as posted on www.uci.ch. Riders with highest UCI points are staged first. Remaining without points will be staged by random lot. Every Elite rider registered will be called up to starting line in order of bib number. For all other categories, see OVCX staging procedure at bottom of page.

Racing Age:

A rider's racing age for all cyclo-cross categories is their year of birth subtracted from 2014.

Chip Timing:

All athletes will be chip-timed. Final results for all categories will include finish time and splits for all laps. OVCX riders will use their OVCX chip. Riders that haven't participated in an earlier OVCX race will be issued a new chip at registration. Chip will attach on top of helmet - instructions will be at registration tent.

Airports:

Cincinnati is the nearest international and Dayton the nearest domestic airport. When searching for best rates, some other possibilities are listed.

Directions to event venues:

Directions to Devou Park: (Google: 1600 Montague Rd Covington, KY 41011)

From downtown Cincinnati, take I-75 over the Ohio River, and get off at first exit - 192. Turn right at exit on Crescent. Turn left on Western Rd. Make first right at top of hill onto Devou Drive (look for Devou Park sign). At stop sign, stay straight (not right) and continue up hill. Continue straight at next stop sign, then follow signed directions for parking.

Directions to Kingswood Park: (Google: 4188 Irwin Simpson Road, Mason, OH)

Interstate-71 to Mason-Montgomery Road. North on Mason-Montgomery Road to right Irwin-Simpson Road. Left into the park right before I-71 overpass (across the street from Anthem Insurance).

Directions to Harbin Park: (Google: 1300 Hunter Rd. Fairfield, Ohio 45014)

From Michigan and areas north of Cincinnati : from I-71 and I-75 South, as you are approaching Cincinnati, take I-275 West to exit 36 (Mt. Healthy). Turn right at exit ramp onto 127 and head 2 miles north. Turn left on Hunter Rd. Continue for 1 mile on Hunter Rd. and it runs into Harbin Park. Parking is up the hill on the right/backup parking is on your way in on the left. Bathrooms are behind ranger station near playground.

Host Hotel: Cincinnati Marriott Northeast in Mason is less than 5 minutes from Saturday's Kingswood venue, and less than 30 minutes to Devou Park (Friday's race) and Harbin Park (Sunday's race). Book discounted rate [HERE!](#)

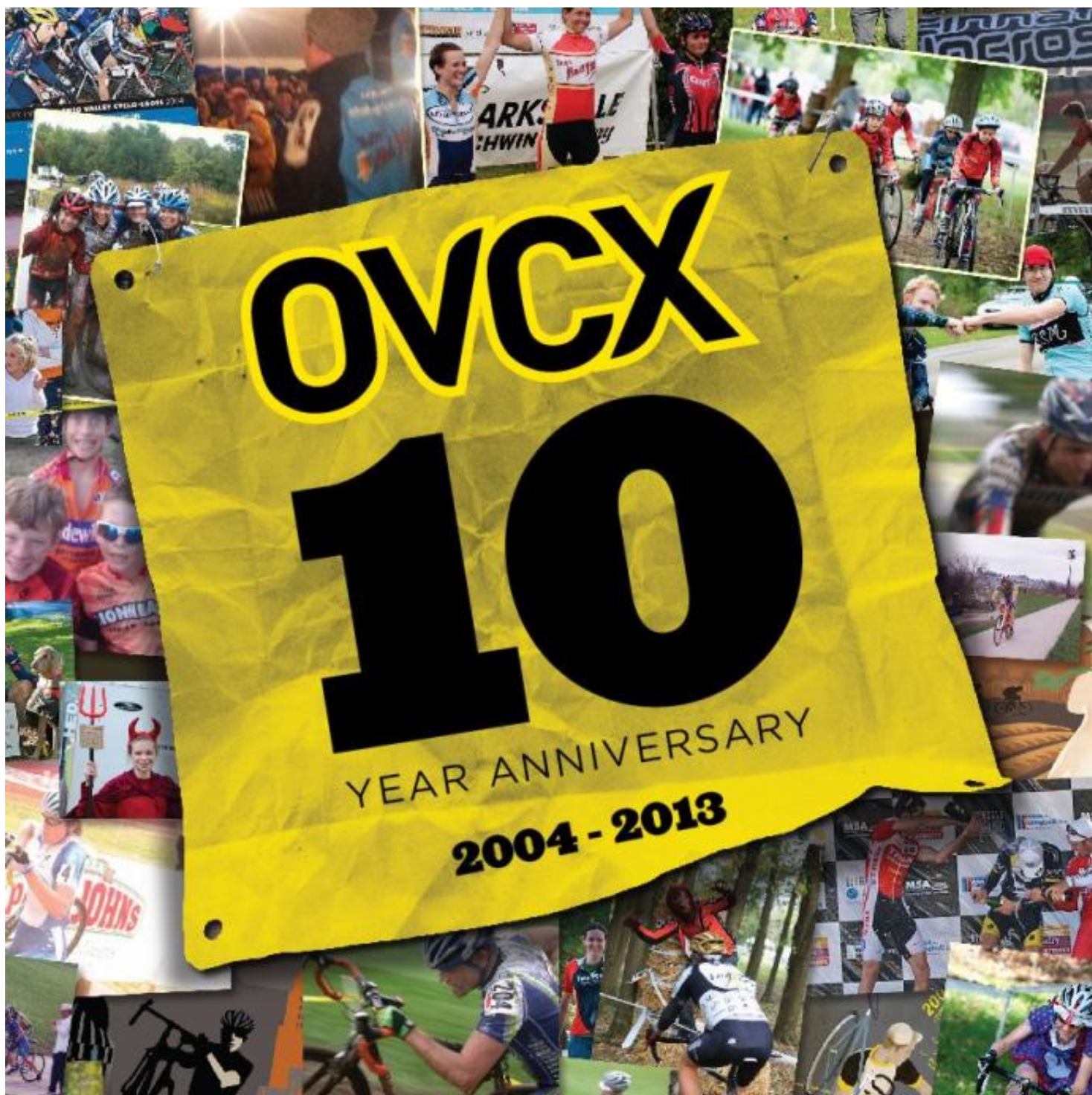

ZIPP raffle for the triple details: All riders that pre-register for all 3 days of racing (Friday/Saturday/Sunday) will automatically be signed up for a huge raffle of Zipp product, highlighted by the grand prize of one pair of ZIPP 303 disc tubular wheels (value \$2500)! Each wave will have it's own raffle. An example of a wave is the Masters Cat 4 wave which goes off first each day. If there are 8 people registered all 3 days for that wave - they are in the raffle for that wave. We will randomly draw which wave will be the **grand prize wave** the Thursday night before day one Devou Park. Grand Prize will be a pair of ZIPP 303 disc wheels. All other waves will have their own **consolation raffles** and the consolation prize is ZIPP gear bag and pair of ti skewers. Need not be present to win. Just must be pre-registered for all 3 days of racing in same category. Names will be drawn Friday at Devou Park by category winners on the awards podium.



OVCX Series: This event is part of the 2013 Ohio Valley Cyclocross Series. For series schedule of events and complete rules & info, please visit OVCX.COM.

Registration: For racers that miss pre-registration, walk-up registration will be available at the race for an additional \$10. The registration table opens up 2 hours before the start of the first race. Registration closes for an event 45 minutes before its start.

OVCX Start Line Staging: Non-UCI categories scheduled to start at the same time will go off in one wave, with individual categories intermixed. First to be staged on the line are those that pre-register at least 2 weeks out from the close of pre-reg (**DEADLINE FOR THIS WILL BE IS OCT 17TH AT MIDNIGHT**), and they will be staged by their Crossresults.com ranking. Next staged will be everyone that pre-registers from 2 weeks out til the close of pre-registration – and they also will be staged by their Crossresults.com ranking. Those that register on raceday will line up at the back. This system will work for all combined categories going off the starting line at the same time. Again, each

category will get scored separately as well, and get a podium celebration each day as well as OVCX series points for their category.

Chip Timing: Each rider is provided a free custom OVCX timing chip for the top of their helmet at their first OVCX race they attend. **It can and should be used the entirety of the OVCX Series.** If they are lost, chip must be replaced at a cost of \$10. Event results will contain finish times, as well as splits for each lap.

Results: Full results will be posted to USA Cycling within 24 hrs of completion of event. Categories will be broken out for OVCX series scoring only; USAC results will have the full wave results (for higher potential ranking points).

OVCX Series Points: Top 3 finishers for each category at the end of the season are recognized at the awards party after the final race at Brookside Cross Cup in Indianapolis December 15th. Each race participant earns points, and their best 7 finishes are calculated for their overall score at the end of the season.
