ANTI-DOPING:

The MudFund Derby City Cup is subject to UCI/USADA/USAC Anti-doping Examination Regulations and all UCI competitors and team personnel must abide by these regulations. Any riders with a non-negative test result (following any adjudication process) will forfeit any prizes won at the MudFund Derby City Cup.

The location and list of riders required to report will be posted at the announcers' stage prior to the finish of the race. The racers will be required to report to medical control within 30 minutes of the finish the event or, when applicable, 30 minutes after the awards and press conference.



It is the responsibility of the rider and/or his team personnel to ensure that he reports to Anti-doping within the required timeframe.

EVENT MEDICAL STAFF:

MudFund Derby City Cup medical personnel will be on site at the event. A first aid tent and/or ambulance can be found near the start/finish line at the event for treatment of minor injuries for athletes, staff and spectators.

AWARDS PROTOCOL & CLASSIFICATIONS:

FINISH PROCEDURE:

Immediately following completion of each OVCX/UCI category race, the top 3 riders must proceed directly to the podium area. MudFund Derby City Cup staff will personally escort the top 3 UCI riders to the podium tent.

AWARDS PROTOCOL:

OVCX Categories: Immediately following conclusion of races UCI Categories: Podium ceremony and post-race press conference

Pro riders shall remain in podium area briefly after ceremony for interviews. Riders should then report to medical control as required.

UCI PRIZE PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

Prize money will be paid on site following each event. Checks will be mailed to riders who do not collect their prize money.

All tax forms can be obtained at registration. No money can be paid ulness you have provided the following current information on a W9 form (US riders):

- Social Security Number or Tax ID Number
- Exact legal name of payee
- Mailing Address

All prize-winners who are non-resident aliens and who have not provided evidence that they are exempt from withholding tax, IRS W9 form is available onsite at registration.

Merchandise prizes for OVCX categories should be picked up at registration after results are final. Merchandise will NOT be mailed and will be donated to volunteers.

REGULATIONS:

All MudFund Derby City Cup UCI events shall be held under the 2013 UCI Regulations. All other categories shall be held under USA Cycling regulations.

PARTICIPATION:

- Junior Women 17-18 may compete with the Elite Women provided they possess a valid UCI international license.
- Junior Men 17-18 may NOT compete in the Men's Elite competition and must hold a valid UCI license for the UCI inscribed races.
- The category to which a license-holder belongs on 1 January of the civil year following will be used for his participation in events for the whole season. In other words, a riders age for all categories is determined by his/her age on December 31, 2014.
- All UCI Elite Men, UCI Junior Men, and UCI Elite Women must possess a current UCI international license.
- For all other categories (OVCX), a USA Cycling license is required.

START ORDER:

UCI ELITE- Women & Men

UCI rule 5.1.043: The start order for UCI races will be determined by the order of latest published UCI cyclocross point classification from the highest to lowest, as posted on the UCI website (www.uci.ch). If no classification has yet been published for the current season, the start order will be determined by the final UCI individual cyclocross classification from the previous year.

- Riders with zero (0) UCI points will be able to draw their own number up to 3 hours before the race at registration each race day. After the 3 hour time riders that have not picked their number will be automatically assigned a random start number by registration staff and witnessed by UCI official.
- With ten minutes to start, the Race Announcer will begin introducing, in the UCI Men's race, the first two rows (16 riders), and, in the UCI Women's and Junior Men's race, the front row (8 riders).
- UCI Riders are advised to report 15 minutes before their respective start.

UCI ELITE – Junior Men

- As per the most recently published UCI cyclo-cross individual classification for the current season for the category concerned. If no classification has yet been published for the current season, the start order will be determined by the final UCI individual cyclo-cross classification for the previous season. After all UCI Classified riders, Start Order for Junior 17/ 18 riders will be determined by drawing lots one hour before the race. Each Junior Rider will be allowed to draw their number based on their order of registration. The number drawn will be their Bib / Start number. They will be called up in numerical order. Riders not present when their name is called for the drawing will draw last.

ALL USAC (OVCX) Cycling Categories (Men, Women, Juniors, Masters, SingleSpeed, Etc.)

- In order to encourage early pre-registration and consistent OVCX event participation, starting row positions will be based on both rider ranking and pre-reg.
- First row for each wave (as many as 8 positions) are reserved for top 8 OVCX series wave leaders in current standings. Ranked riders must be pre-registered for event to earn call-up spot. Next riders are staged by their Crossresults.com ranking all riders pre-registered up to the 2 Sundays out prior to the rate date. The remaining staging is done by Crossresults.com rankings all riders pre-registered after the 2 weeks out period and then staged by ranking. Race day registrants are staged last.

PIT REQUIREMENTS:

Pit Passes—1 Mechanic per rider will be issued a pass with rider numbers at packet pick up / registration. No other personnel shall be allowed in the Pit Zone. MudFund Derby City Cup organizers will provide pit pass badges prior to packet pick up at registration.

MudFund Derby City Cup personnel will check for credentials in the pits and anybody found without proper credential will not be allowed in this area.

PIT & BIKE WASHING:

- One large two (2) sided UCI legal pit is located on the course, very close to the Pro team parking and Expo area.
- The Pit Area is for the exchange of race bikes, wheels or feeding during the course of a rider's event. On either side of Pit Area is the exchange lane, which is for riders' entry and exit only. Do not stand in the exchange lanes during a race. Between exchange lanes is the median for storage of bikes, wheels, and riders' assistants.



- Only riders and riders' mechanics/assistants may be present inside the Pit Area during the race.
- Gasoline powered pressure washers will be located at the pits for mechanics/assistants tending to racers on course, ONLY.
- Use of pressure washers by unauthorized personnel at unauthorized times will result in disqualification.

UNAUTHORIZED REFRESHMENTS (UCI RULE 5.1.038):

- In the event of warm weather conditions (Above 20C/68F) the commissaire's panel may decide to allow water hand-ups ("feeding") in the Pit Lane ONLY.
- Under those conditions, feeding is not allowed during the first two (2) and last two (2) laps.
- Accepting Hand-Ups from spectators including cans, bottles, cups, food (such as, Derby Pie, Brats & Waffles), Bourbon, money, etc. – is NOT permitted and may result in disqualification.

EQUIPMENT:

NON-UCI (USAC) RACES:

- USAC equipment rules apply
- Cyclocross, mountain, hybrid, bmx & road style bikes, etc., are allowed.
- Tandems, unicycles, recumbents, tricycles, etc. are not allowed.
- Flat bars are allowed, but bar ends must be removed.
- Bicycle helmets are required to be worn by riders on the course at ALL times

UCI ELITE RACES:

- UCI equipment rules apply
- Cyclocross &/or road bikes with drop bars, only
- Tires no wider than 33 mm
- Bicycle helmets are required to be worn by riders on the course at all times

REGISTRATION:

Entry Fees: UCI Men & Women: \$45

UCI Juniors: Comped (Be sure to thank Tim Johnson)

OVCX Men & Women: \$35 Juniors (non-UCI): \$7 The MudFund Derby City Cup is rain or shine. NO REFUNDS!

Pre-registration is mandatory for all UCI categories.

For categories allowing race day registration (OVCX), a \$10 race day charge will be added to registration cost. Registration will close when field size limit is reached, if applicable. Pre-registration is encouraged to avoid the day-of fee.



Registration and number pickup for each race closes 30 minutes prior to the start time for non-UCI races.

NUMBERS PRESENTATION:

Elite Men, Women and Junior Men with start numbers 1-10 will be required to pick up their numbers on Friday evening (November 8th), at a specified location. Attendance is required from 6:30-7:30 PM and will include a numbers presentation ceremony and pre-race press conference.

PRE-RIDING THE COURSE:

- The course will be open for pre-riding and inspection on Friday, November 8th, from 2:00 PM thru 4:00 PM.
- On race day the course shall be open for warm up during the designated Course Inspection times, noted in the schedule.
- Helmets must be worn AT ALL TIMES when riding the course & failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- Warming up on the course while a race is in progress, or at any other unauthorized time, is strictly prohibited and will result in disqualification.
