

#### AWARDS PROTOCOL AND CLASSIFICATIONS

Awards Protocol:

The riders that must report to the podium are the Race Winner, 2nd and 3rd place.

Morning categories: Immediately following conclusion of Masters 45+ races all categories

Young Juniors: Immediately following races UCI Juniors 17/18: immediately after race

Masters 35+ Podium Ceremony: Immediately after race

UCI Elite Women Podium Ceremony and post-race press conference: immediately after race

UCI Elite Men/U-23 Men Podium Ceremony and post-race press conference

Pro Riders shall remain in podium area briefly after ceremony for interviews. For specific categories the post event press conference will be held on site. Riders should then report to medical control as required. See specific information in this Tech Guide.

#### PRIZE PAYMENT PROCEDURE

Individual event prize money will be paid on site following each event. Checks will be mailed to riders who do not collect their prize money.

All tax forms can be obtained at registration. No money can be paid unless you have provided the following current information on a W9 form (US Riders):

Social Security Number or Tax ID Number Exact name of payee to receive payment Mailing Address

All prize-winners who are non-resident aliens and who have not provided evidence that they are exempt from withholding tax. IRS W9 is available on site at registration


Merchandise prizes for the amateur categories should be picked up at registration after results are final. Merchandise prizes will NOT be mailed.

## **REGULATIONS:**

All Deschutes Brewery Cup (D.B.C.) shall be held under the 2013 UCI regulations.

#### Participation:

- \* Junior Women 17-18 may compete with the Elite Women provided they possess a valid UCI international license.
- \* A rider's 2013 racing age, according to UCI 5.1.001 The category to which the license-holder belongs on 1 January of the civil year following will be used for his participation in events for the whole season; or in other words, a rider's racing age for all categories is determined by his/her age on December 31, 2014.
- \*All Elite Men, U-23 Men, and Elite Women must possess a current UCI international License.

#### Start Order:

#### \* Elite Men, U23 Men, and Elite Women:

- 1. As per the most recently published UCI cyclo-cross individual classification of the current season (or the final classification of the previous season if no classification has yet been published for the current season);
  - 2. Unclassified riders: by drawing lots.

Riders that do not have points will be able to draw their own number up to 3 hours before the race at registration. See hours and location of registration in the Tech Guide. After the 3 hour time riders that have not picked their number will be assigned a random start number by USGP registration staff and witnessed by the UCI official.

At the Start, D.B.C. staff will determine how many rows will be cordoned off and all riders, those ranked and those unranked, must remain behind this cordon. With ten (10) minutes to start, the Race Announcer will begin introducing, in the elite men's race, the first two (2) rows (16 riders), and, in the elite women's race, the front row (8 riders). These top riders will be introduced in the Finish Area and then proceed to the Start Area Grid to fill in their respective rows. Simultaneously, USGP staff will call-up the remaining rows of UCI ranked riders. Riders are advised to report 15 minutes before their respective start.

Per UCI regulations rider call-up is a maximum of ten minutes before the start. If riders are not present with 10 minutes to start and miss their call-up, they will lose their start grid position.

#### Master 35+ Men

Master 35+ Men will be called up based on the 2012 USGP Masters 35+ ranking - ONLY PRE-REGISTERED RIDERS WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR CALL-UP POSITION.

One row of eight (8) Masters 35+ men with points from host venue's regional/local series will be called up. (Top 3 each from Cross Crusade, MFG Cross, Seattle Cup). All other riders will be called up by order of registration.

#### Masters 45+ Men:

Master 45+ Men will be called up based on the 2012 USGP Masters 45+ ranking - ONLY PRE-REGISTERED RIDERS WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR CALL-UP POSITION.

Any riders who were ranked in the 2012 USGP Masters 35+ Series will be given that equivalent ranking in the Masters 45+.

One row of eight (8) PRE-REGISTERED Masters 45+ Men with points from the host venue's local/regional series will then be called up. (Top 3 each from Cross Crusade, MFG Cross, Seattle Cup)

#### Registration:

Entry fees: Pre-registration fees Categories: Elite and U-23 Men \$45; Elite Women \$45. All other categories \$30.

#### **Friday Night Number Presentation Procedure:**

Elite Men with start numbers 1-10 and Elite Women with start numbers 1-10 will be required to pick up their numbers on Friday evening at a specified location. Attendance is required from 6:30-7:30 pm and will include a number presentation ceremony and pre-race press conference.

#### **Anti-Doping:**

The Deschutes Brewery Cup events are subject to UCI/USAD Anti Doping Examination Regulations and all competitors and team personnel must abide by these regulations. Any riders with a non-negative test result (following any adjudication process) will forfeit any prizes won.

The location and list of riders required to report will be posted at the announcers' stage prior to the finish of the race. The racers will be required to report to medical control within 30 minutes after the finish of the event or, when applicable, 30 minutes after the awards and press conference.

It is the responsibility of the rider and/or his team personnel to insure that he reports to Anti- Doping within the required time.

#### **Event Medical Staff:**

Medical personnel will be on site at each event. A first aid tent and/or ambulance can be found near the Start/

Finish Line at each event for treatment of minor injuries for athletes, staff and spectators.
