

THE DETAILS FOR WORS AMATEUR CROSS-COUNTRY RACE

Course: The Cascade Mountain Cross-Country course takes it up a notch with a challenging mix of punchy climbs, forested single-track, technical descents, rock gardens, switchbacks and fast traverses while providing options for racers of all abilities. Racers pass through the area in front of the lodge several times each lap to provide outstanding spectator opportunities.



Race Categories: Normal WORS Categories with these exceptions: 1) Pros will race the Pro XCT on Saturday and 2) Juniors, race age 14 and under competing for a WORS overall will race their regular series category, others may choose the appropriate category from among the Junior, Citizen, or Sport.

Classes & Start Times:

Sunday - 8:30 AM * Citizen (USA Cycling Cat 3) & First Timers:

Junior (male) 15-16, 17-18, Men: 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-54, 55-59, 60 & over, Clydesdale** 39 & under and Clydesdale 40 & over. Junior (female): 15-18, Women: 19-24, 25-34, 35-44, 45-54, and 55 & over.

Saturday - 8:00 AM * WORS Sport (USA Cycling Cat 2 for women & recreational men):

Junior (male): 13-14, 15-16, 17-18, Junior (female): 15-18. Men: 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, Masters 60-64 (open to all categories), Masters 65 & over (open to all categories), Single Speed, Clydesdale^{**} 39 & under and Clydesdale^{**} 40 & over. Women: 19-24, 25-34, 35-44, and Masters 45-54, 55 & over (open to all categories) and Single Speed.

Saturday - 9:30 AM * WORS Comp (USA Cycling Cat 2 men looking for Regional & National recognition): Men: 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, and Masters 55-59 (open to all categories).

Open (Cat 1 & 2 and advanced riders with a 1 day license): Men: Single Speed and Clydesdale. Women:

Saturday - 11:00 PM * Cat 1 Male: 15-16, 17-18, 19-23, 24-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44 and 45-54. Female: 15-18, 19-23, 24-34 and 35-44.

Registration: Register online before midnight July 20th at www.wors.org or by mail before July 17th.

Late / On-site Registration: Friday 2-6 PM, Saturday 7 AM* and Sunday 7-9 AM*

*Registration closes 1/2 hour before your race.

Sport, Citizen, & Junior 18 & under - ^{\$}20⁵⁴ With USA Cycling Mountain Annual License, ^{\$}30⁶⁴ with One Day USA Cycling License. Try-It-Out - ^{\$}30⁶⁴ with One Day USA Cycling License included.

Late or Day of Entry Fees:

Elite (Pro/Cat 1) - ^{\$}41, Cat 1 Juniors (Racing age 15-18) - ^{\$}36 (UCI International or USA Cycling Cat 1 license required). No One Day license option. Comp, Open & Sport, 19 & over - ^{\$}36 With USA Cycling Mountain Annual License, ^{\$}46 with One Day USA Cycling License. Citizen, 19 & over - ^{\$}34 With USA Cycling Mountain Annual License, ^{\$}44 with One Day USA Cycling License.

Sport, Citizen, & Junior 18 & under - ^{\$}26 With USA Cycling Mountain Annual License, ^{\$}36 with One Day USA Cycling License. Try-It-Out - ^{\$}36 One Day USA Cycling License included.

All USA Cycling Mountain License holders must present their license at race registration to avoid being charged for a one day license fee.
