



For the Masters 50+/60+ category, a daily winner's jersey and daily omnium leader's jersey will be awarded for each of the following age groups in the category: 50+, 55+, 60+ and 65+.
- Intelligentsia Cup Prairie State Cycling Series will be a run as an omnium, with points awarded based on rider's place in each race. Overall placing will be determined by series cumulative point totals and recognized on the podium on July 26, 2015.
