

Race Number Pickup/Sign In For PRO Races

All riders must present a completed USAC 2015 Athlete Release form at registration.

No race numbers will be given out without a signed release form and a current USAC racing license.

The race number pick up/sign in location for ALL riders will only be open during these hours. In order to prepare our system to properly record race results our event roster will be closed promptly at 5:15 pm.

No race numbers will be given out after that time.

Riders not receiving numbers by closing of number pickup will not be allowed to start.

Registration/Race Numbers for Amateur Shootout

Registration for the Amateur Shootout will be available online at www.bikereg.com. The registration is open to ALL Cat 2 & 3 riders from 16 years of age above up.

Number Pickup for Amateur Shootout

All registered riders in the Amateur Shootout must sign in at the Registration Tent at the Bank of America Plaza, 101 S. Tryon Street from 3:00 - 4:30 pm. Please be aware that sign in close promptly at 4:30 pm. No sign in allowed after that time.

Event Rider Call Up For Pro Women & Men

<u>Pro Riders:</u> The call up will be predetermined by the race director on April 25, 2016. Call up lists will be available at number pickup at the Bank of America Plaza, 101 S. Tryon Street. We will allow as many call up as our time schedule allows. Staging for call up will be behind the VIP areas directly across from the start/finish stage. There will be event staff there to assist.

We are on a strict timetable so please don't miss your call up! All remaining riders will be staged 150 meters prior to the start line.

<u>Amateur Shootout Riders</u>: Amateur Shootout riders will be staged at Start/Finish line. The previous winners of this event will be recognized.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Medical Control /Anti-Doping

The Charlotte Criterium is subject to USADA Anti Doping Examination. All competitors and team personnel must abide by these regulations. Any rider found positive will forfeit all prizes won at the event.

The list of riders required to report will be posted at the start/finish stage. The riders will be required to report to medical control within a reasonable time after the awards and protocol ceremonies. It is the responsibility of the rider and/or their team personnel to insure that they report to Anti-Doping within the required time. Anti-doping will be located in the **Omni Hotel**: The **Omni Hotel** is located at 132 E Trade St.

directly behind the start/finish line. USADA chaperones will escort you to the testing room.

Please note! The awards for both men and women are held directly after the finish of the men's race. Top 3 riders from each event must report to the finish area immediately after the Men's Pro Race. Please participate in the awards ceremony before reporting for testing. Your USADA chaperone will stay with you.

Awards Ceremony

Pro Women's Race Post Race Interview:
The winner of the women's race should report to the Start/Finish stage immediately following the finish of her race. The race announcer will conduct an interview before the start of the men's race and during the beginning of the men's race.

Pro & Shootout Awards Ceremony: There will be a combined awards ceremony with presentation of flowers to the first 3 places in both the women's and men's Pro race as well as a winner's check presentation to the Pro race winners. Amateur Shootout top 3 will received trophies. The awards ceremony for ALL will be held directly after the finish of the men's race.

The top 3 riders from both the PRO Men's and Women's and Amateur Shootout race must report to the Start/Finish stage <u>immediately</u> after the finish of the men's race at approximately 9:20 pm. These riders must report to the Awards Ceremony wearing team uniforms of both shorts and jersey.

It is imperative that riders and managers respect our request that you follow the instructions above. There will be live coverage of this event. Your assistance is highly important to us in order to meet our schedules and to give your team maximum exposure.

Participation in the Awards Ceremony is required and must be completed before reporting for testing. *Failure to comply can incur a penalty of up to 50% of prize earnings*.

Prize Payment Procedure

Amateur Shootout Placing Prizes:

All places will be paid out behind the Start/Finish Stage after the start of the Men's Professional Race. Please bring photo ID, Racing License or Race Number to pick up prizes.

Pro Event Women's and Men's Prizes:

All NCC riders/teams must have a tax ID number on file with registration or prize checks cannot be sent out. Please bring W9 Forms with you or be prepared to fill one out at race number pickup. Riders on non-professional teams must submit Social Security Numbers.

Prize money, including cash premes, for The Charlotte Criterium will be paid within 30 days following the event and after receiving the official results and results of any medical control testing.

For all teams, checks will be sent to team managers or official team representatives, one per team. Please make sure you file your W9 forms at number pickup with corporate and team name.

<u>Pro EVENT</u>: No prize money can be paid unless you have provided a completed W9 form or provided your Social Security Number at registration. The following information is required:

- Your Social Security Number or Tax ID Number with the Exact Name of Payee (Team) to Receive Payment; AND
- The Mailing Address.

Media Credentials: To have any course access all media will need credentials. You may also register for press/media credentials at the race registration in the Bank of America Plaza, 101 S. Tryon Street, (behind the start/finish area) between 3:00 pm - 5:00 pm. All photographers and press must be properly identified and credentialed by the Race Director or Sponsorship & Public Relations Coordinator. Any photographers or press working in the start/finish area must obey the instructions of the Race Director or Sponsorship & Public Relations Coordinator. These rules are in place to help in the safety of you and the competitors. No photographer or press is allowed inside the fencing (on course) while races are in progress, unless granted an "All Access Pass." No exceptions.

<u>Awards Ceremony</u>: A fenced in area in front of the Awards Podium will be available for all photographers and media for the post-race awards ceremony.
